Program Year 2011 - 2012

Date of Birth	Age and Options
9/1/06 to 8/31/07	<p>Four year old children</p> <p>May be enrolled in part-day classroom. Home-based options, Family Literacy and Full Day programs available at some centers.</p>
9/1/07 to 8/31/08	<p>Three year old children</p> <p>May be enrolled in home-based options at numerous locations, and, in some locations, part-day classroom options. Family Literacy and Full Day programs available at some centers. <i>**Children with an IEP are eligible to begin center-based Head Start Services at the age of 2 years 11 months. **At the discretion of the district. 3 year olds may be placed in a 4 year old classroom if the district determines this to be the most appropriate placement.**</i></p>
9/1/08 and younger	<p>Age eligible for Early Head Start options only. Children 2 years 11 months and younger <u>as of day of enrollment</u> may be enrolled in EHS Full Day, EHS Family Literacy, or EHS home-based options where available.</p> <p>Income eligible pregnant women may be enrolled in EHS options.</p>
